Snowman Tic Tac Holder—1 oz box

Supplies Needed:

Solid colored cardstock

White cardstock

Black and orange scrape paper

Holiday patterned cardstock

14 inches of thin ribbon

Adhesive of your choice. (hot glue, tacky glue, glue dots, or double sided tape)

Circle hole punches. Ideal sizes: Punches: 1 1/4" circle, 1" circle, and a 3/4" circle.

Optional: Corner rounder punch, Office hole puncher

Instructions

1. Cut a piece of solid colored cardstock to 3" x 4 1/2".
2. Round corners with a punch or scissors.
3. Use a flat edge to scored the cardstock at 2 1/2" and 2 5/8".
4. Cut a piece of patterned cardstock to 2" x 1 3/4" .
5. Round corners on the top and bottom of the right side only.
6. With tacky glue, glue dots, or double sided tape, adhere a 13" to 14 " ribbon ONLY TO THE FRONT "COVER" (not the spine or back).
7. Adhere the patterned cardstock to the front cover (over the ribbon).
8. To make the bottom of the snowman, punch a 1 1/4 circle through the cover so you see the Tic Tacs.
9. Punch or cut a 3/4" circle and 1" circle in white cardstock and adhere them on top of the bottom punch to make your snowman.
10. Use a normal hole punch to punch black paper to make the eye and buttons for your snowman and adhere to snowman or draw on with black marker.
11. Cut a nose out of orange paper and adhere to snowman.
12. On the inside cover wright "Heard you've been naughty, so here's the scoop — all you get this year is snowman poop!", "He's cut, cuddly, and full of good wishes. He wants to give you these snowman kisses!" or a holiday message of your own choosing.
13. Adhere tic tac to the inside spine of the cardholder.
14. Finish! You are ready to give away this very cool gift!



Snowman Tic Tac Stocking Stuffer — 1 oz box

Supplies Needed:

White cardstock
4 inch pipe cleaner
2 small craft pom poms
Black pen
Orange marker
Glue gun
Tic Tac Box, 1 oz

1. Cut the White Cardstock to 1 3/4" x 6 1/4".
2. Score the paper 2 3/4" from the edge on both sides.
3. Draw a snowman face on the bottom of the strip
4. Hot glue cardstock to tic tac container. Make sure the opening of the tic tacs is at the bottom!
5. Bend the pipe cleaner into an arch and hot glue to either side of the snowman's face on the tic tac container.
6. Hot Glue a pom pom over the top of the pipe cleaner ends to make earmuffs.
7. Optional: Write a fun saying on the back of your snowman. Keep in mind which way the text will be facing when glued to the tic tac container.

Finished! You have a very cool stocking stuffer!
